Each amendment must be specifically gazetted into New Zealand Law - New Zealand (Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code) Food Standards 2002. The latest published amendment – No. 28 gazetted 5 November 2009 – adopting up to and including Amendment 112 to the Food Standards Code. Amendment 113 is yet to be adopted in New Zealand at the time of publishing this version.
